Administrative news:

Over the last 3 months there was plenty of discussion on raising chapter dues due to increased costs for administrative management of the chapter (website fees, etc.)

At the 20 Jan 2023 chapter meeting a vote was held, and passed with an overwhelming majority, to raise chapter dues from \$15 to \$20. Additionally, it was voted on to make this effective **01 Jan 2024**.

Back in March 2020 I posted this article. And I think if you asked anyone who attended the recent refresher riding class they will agree to what I said, "Rusty, Tighten, Polish". Some may think I'm talking about your motorcycle and you would be wrong.



Riding season is here or coming depending on your comfort level. With the reduced level of riding activity experienced during the cold season, not only have our motorcycles suffered from the reduced activity but so have we. Our minds haven't had the need to concentrate on riding, so we may have placed in the back of our minds all the little things that make for a fun and safe ride. So, we are a little RUSTY in our minds and thoughts. It's time to start thinking about what's needed for a safe ride.

As with the motorcycles, our physical capabilities have reduced from lack of use. We all need to TIGHTEN up physically. Tired muscles during riding could lead to slow physical responses when needed, to avoid a negative outcome. Muscle memory is a must for safe riding.

While you are polishing up those motorcycles you might want to take the time and POLISH up your riding skills. Practice those skills such as emergency braking, turning, and defensive riding so you can enjoy and have a safe ride.

Bayside HOG completes Advanced Rider Course

On Saturday, 18 Feb, 11 members of Bayside H.O.G., including Doug Burdett, Cliff Pulver, LaMonte Wiggins, Sarah Wiggins, Terry Gay, Craig Corris, Lee Spencer, TJ High, Mike Matusiak, and Mike Lacy, completed an Advanced Rider Course conducted by the Hampton Roads Motorcycle Safety Foundation (HRMSF) and hosted by the dealership.

The course covered approximately 1.5 hours of classroom presentation and discussion of the fundamentals; Safety/Risk Factors and Offset, Breaking and Swerving Factors, Body Posture and Curves, Curve Factors, and Brake -Assisted Steering (Trail Braking).

This was followed by 6+ hrs. of practical application using various fun interactive activities to improve perception and hazard awareness enhancing both basic operating skills and crash-avoidance skills with an emphasize on improved braking and cornering finesse.

Chapter Membership ...

As noted, previously in this edition, on Friday, January 20, 2023 the Bayside H.O.G. Chapter voted to change the Chapter By-Laws increasing annual Dues from \$15.00 per year to \$20.00 per year. The Chapter also voted to keep the membership term on a calendar year cycle, January 1 to December 31. The purpose of this membership cycle, is to match the National H.O.G. organization which observes the same cycle, thus improving our efficiency in managing physical membership forms and waivers. Except for "Life" and "Charter" members, all memberships will expire on their natural one-year anniversary date in 2023, but no later than December 31st of this year. All memberships must be renewed in 2022/2023.


